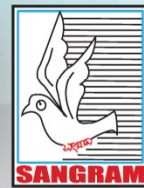

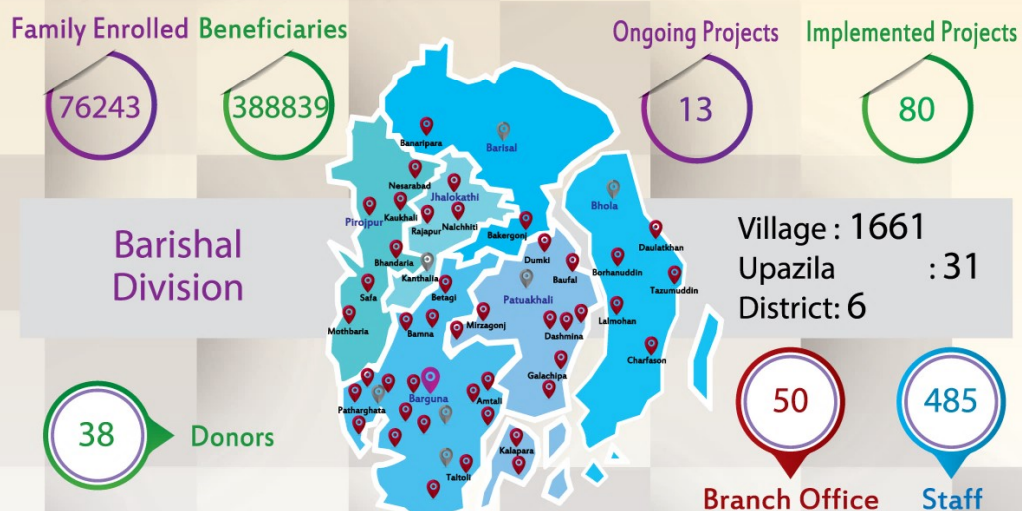

Doctors come from Ispahani Islamia Eye Institute and Hospital in selected date for providing free of cost eye treatment. The patients those who are needed operation are taken to Ispahani Eye Hospital at Barishal. After completing operation, patients are sent to their houses. In this process of eye operation each of the patient need only 750/= Taka. Paramedics and staffs of microfinance assist doctors for eye camp management.
